Dear Parent/Carers

We wanted to let you know that we were informed of a positive pupil COVID case in Oaks on Thursday, 7th October. This is the second case in the last 10 days. The contacts of the pupils concerned have been advised to take a PCR test and they have returned to school if they remained well. Staff have also been for PCR tests and continue to take daily lateral flow tests for 10 days following contact with the positive case.

We continue to work closely with Public Health England, and we will be continuing with the enhanced measures such as:

- Facemasks in communal areas and for close working
- Dinners in classes
- No large gatherings for training or events
- Enhanced cleaning during the day for frequently used areas / touch points
- Internal track and trace for contacts of positive cases.

We continue to encourage household members over the age of 11 to take twice weekly lateral flow tests to help us to identify cases promptly and keep everyone safe. Just let us know if you require any more lateral flow testing kits.
