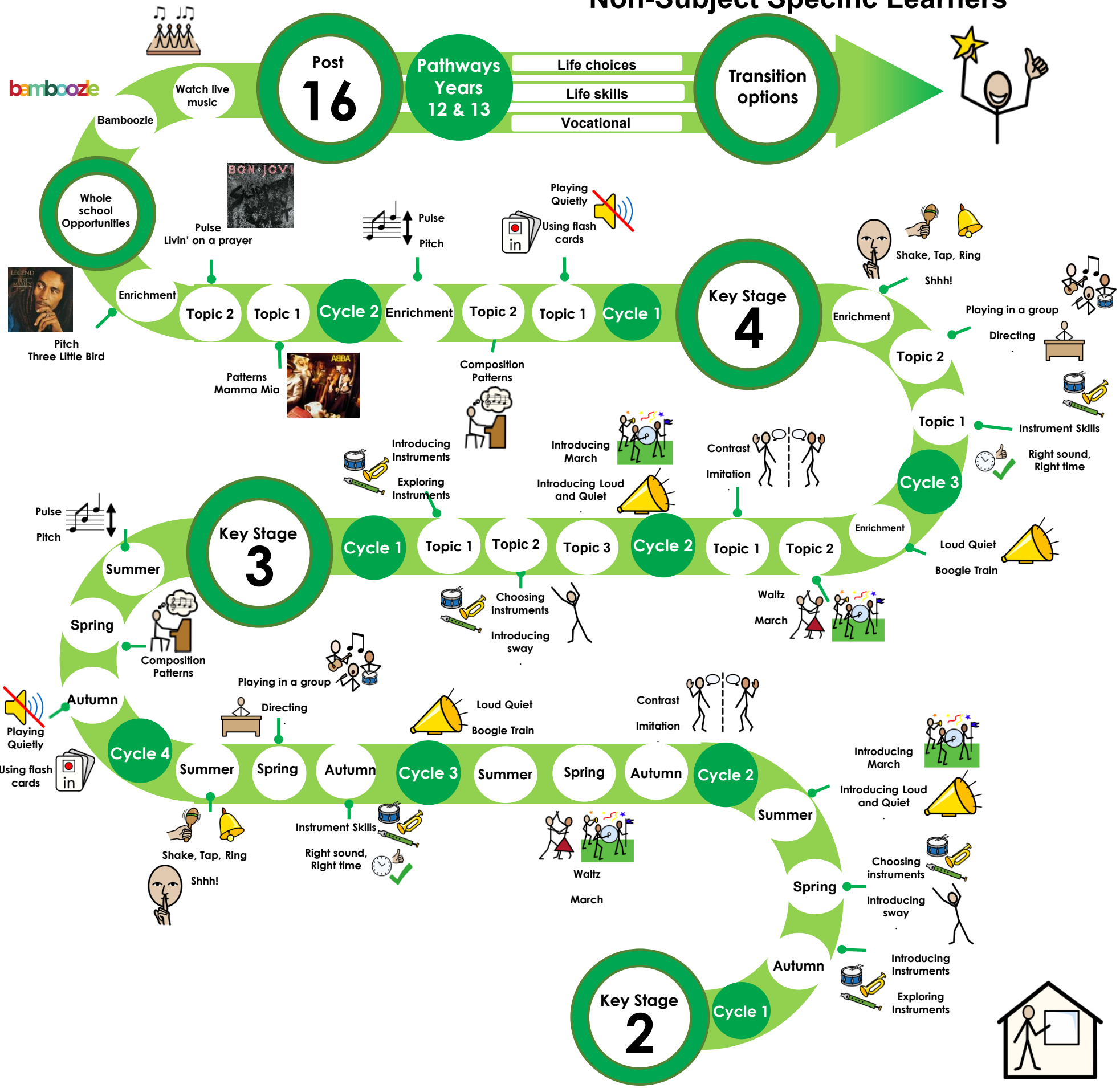


# Forest Way School Music Thematic Learning Journey Non-Subject Specific Learners



## Thrive at Forest Way

Pupils not yet ready for formal learning by the end of KS1 transition to our Life Choices pathway. Assessed via the Engagement Model, these students benefit from repetitive lesson structures designed to build realisation, persistence, and anticipation. In addition to standard Music lessons, they participate in Musical Interaction sessions guided by the Musical Play Framework.

Forest Way School is a registered centre for Trinity College London's Arts Award program, offering nationally recognised qualifications across Art, Design Technology, and Music. These awards are integrated into the curriculum, allowing students to build portfolios, attend workshops, and showcase their creative achievements. Year 9 students work toward the Discover Award, followed by the Explore Award in Year 11. Post-16 learners with a dedicated interest in the arts can further progress to the Bronze and Silver levels to support their aspirations for creative careers.
