

Forest Way School Reading for Meaning Learning Journey



Preparing for potential further education or employment requirements e.g. preparing for and undertaking qualifications, reading and responding to job applications, reading college prospectuses.

Travel training – travelling safely on foot, by car or using public transport by reading and appropriately responding to road signs, the Highway Code and timetables.

Making choices and carrying out actions informed by reading in real life scenarios – e.g. paying bills that arrive in the post, choosing from menus, following recipes, making

Reading and understanding simple sentences.

Listening to, joining in with and recalling stories and poems.

Showing anticipation through turning pages.

Experiencing story through listening to them and exploring associated props/resources.

Listening to simple songs and rhymes.

Focussing attention on specific sounds, words and objects.
